July 3, 2022 | Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

After strong language about the difficulties of discipleship, Jesus immediately appoints 72 people to go ahead of him to every town and place he plans to visit, proclaiming that the Kingdom of God is at hand. He sends them in pairs.

Jesus admits it will be difficult, that he is sending them out like lambs among wolves. Yet they are to bring nothing with them, not even a money bag or sandals. They are to greet no one on the way so as not to be distracted from their mission. When they enter a house, their message is simply "peace." The response they will receive may be positive or negative. They are not to demand special treatment but eat and drink whatever is given them. They are to heal the sick as a sign that the Kingdom of God is at hand for them. Even in the case of such rejection they should know that the Kingdom of God is at hand
